_____ I hereby give permission for One to One Mentoring staff to contact my child's school and make an appointment to visit my child to conduct interviews during the school day.

I give One to One Mentoring permission to share information regarding my child's background and family history after the match has been made, whenever pertinent. I also give staff permission to speak to One to One Mentoring board members regarding my child when necessary.

Thank you for your interest in One to One Mentoring

We believe that mentoring is one of the best ways to positively impact a youth's life. We realize that you care about the well-being of your child very much by enrolling him or her in our program. We ask for your patience, as sometimes it can take a while to find the right person for your child. We thoroughly screen volunteers (including running criminal and driving background checks) to make sure that all children in our program are matched with a safe, trustworthy, responsible, committed adult.

What happens next?

Once One to One Mentoring staff believes they have found a Mentor for your child, we will contact you to tell you about the person to see if you agree that they would be a good match with your child. You also have the opportunity to meet the Mentor first, if you would like.

Staff will then arrange a match meeting between you, your child, the volunteer Mentor, and a One to One Mentoring staff person. If you prefer, we may hold meetings in your home so that your child is comfortable. During the meeting, contact information will be exchanged, we will discuss when your child and their Mentor will meet each week, and everyone involved will have a chance to talk, ask questions and get to know each other.

Staying in touch

Our number one goal is to help in creating a relationship that is positive and beneficial. This requires the cooperation of all who are involved. Once matched, One to One Mentoring staff will check in with you on a regular basis to ensure that your child is content. Please update staff about any changes in physical or mailing address, phone number, or home situation.

One to One Mentoring staff is always available to speak with you or your child about any problems or issues that may arise during the course of your involvement with our program. Please feel free to contact us at any time before and after your child is matched with their Mentor.
